

Griffith Creek Utility District has a position available for placement on the Board of Commissioners.

Qualifications are:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must be a resident citizen of Tennessee
- Must either reside within the District's boundaries or be a customer of the District
- Must not have an unlawful direct or indirect interest or common law conflict of interest upon assuming office as a commissioner
- Must not be ineligible to serve for failure to obtain mandated utility district commissioner training during a prior term of office as commissioner
- Must not be an employee of the District
- Must not have been convicted of offering or giving a bribe, larceny or any other offense declared infamous by law
- Must not have a judgement for unpaid moneys received in any official capacity due the United States, the State of Tennessee or any county in Tennessee
- Must not be a soldier, sailor, marine, or airman in the regular army, navy or air force of the United States
- Must not be a member of congress or hold any office of profit or trust under any foreign power, other state of the union, or the United States
- Commissioner Training and Continue Education
 - Initial training and education New Commissioners
 - Within one year of the initial appointment or election to the board of commissioners, a new Utility District Commissioner must attend a minimum of 12 Hours of commissioner training and education
 - After receiving initial training each commissioner shall attend a minimum of <u>12</u>
 <u>Hours</u> of training and continued education every three-year continuing education period.
